- Image Supplied is of a similar 4 lane facility, ours will be of a higher specification.

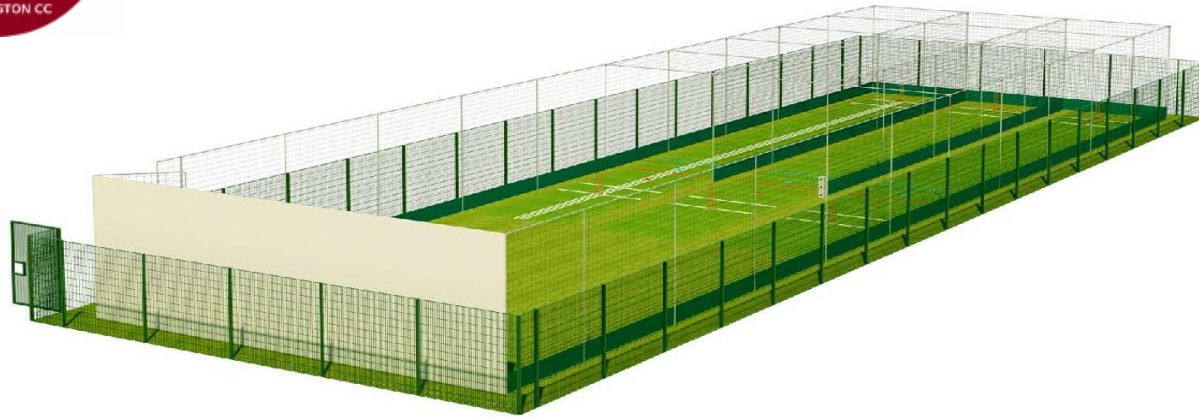

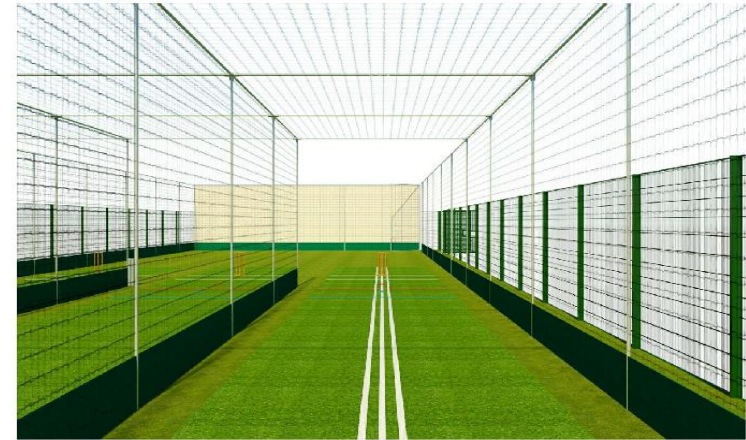

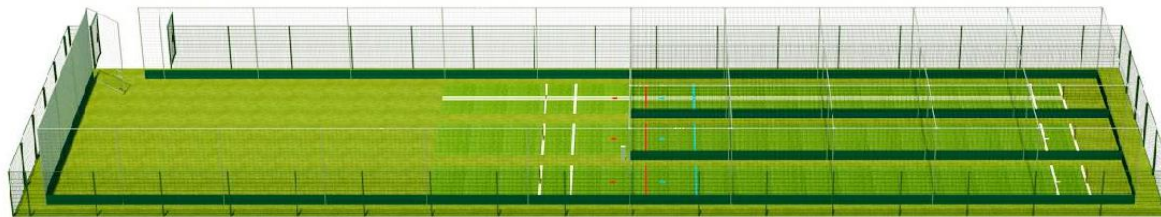
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Isometric View

Side View

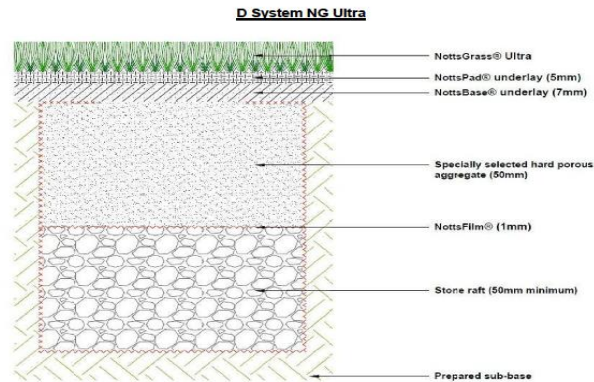


Entrance View

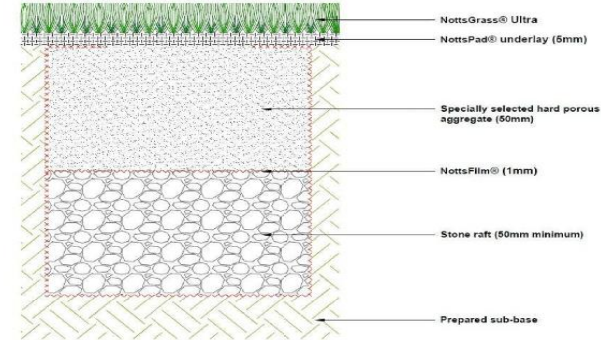

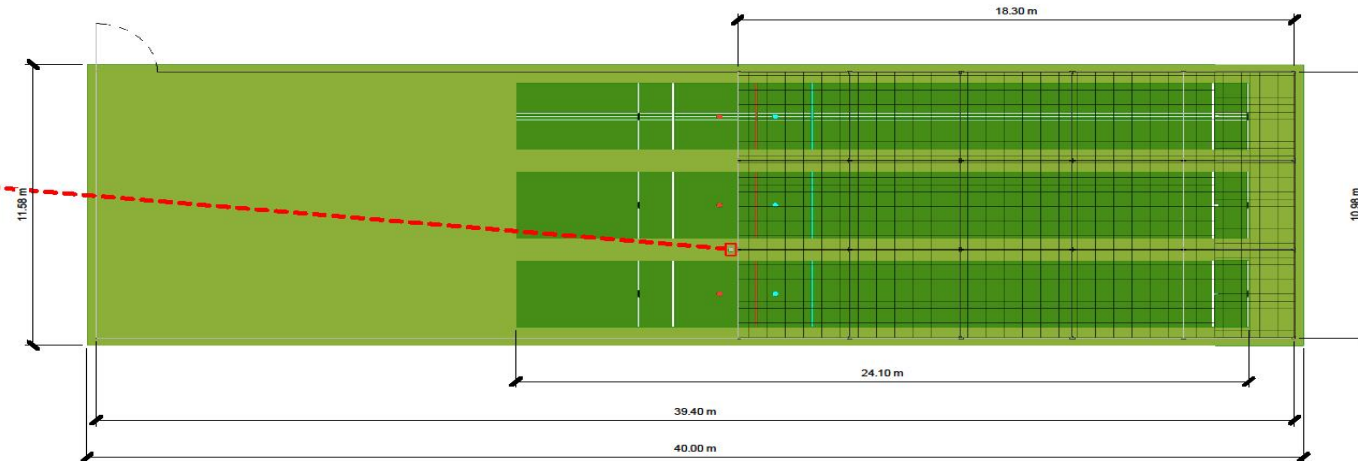
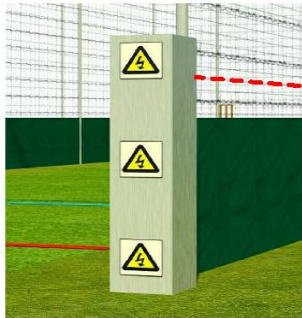


Envelope System NG Ultra

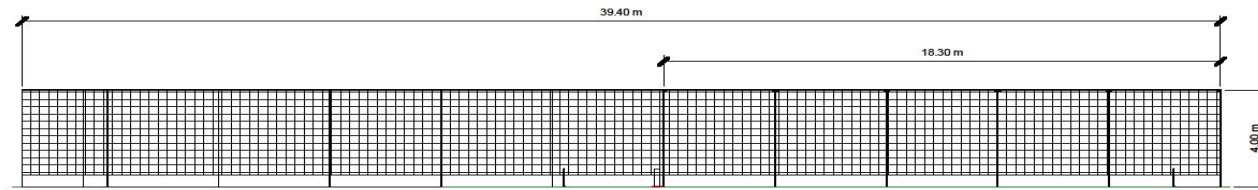
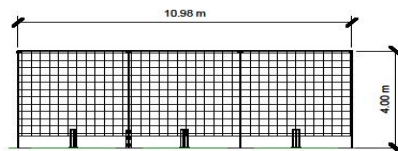


Layout Plan

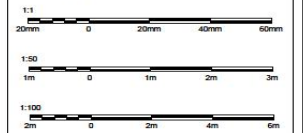
